NEWS FROM BAWDSEY RADAR – YES, WE ARE OPEN!

The Transmitter Block re-opened in June! The museum welcomes visitors on a pre-booked basis every Sunday and Thursday in July. Tickets are on sale via the website www.bawdseyradar.org.uk. Click on 'Visit' to book a date and timed slot. While the operational side of RAF Bawdsey drew to a close in 1991, interest in the site was far from over as most Bawdsey folk will know! Over the past year Bawdsey Radar has produced a series of podcasts called "Under the Radar", telling the story of Britain's earliest radar systems together with the people involved – the scientists – the women on the front line – the decision makers and the politicians. The final podcast "The Rebirth of Bawdsey" is now available and tells of how, since 1991, thanks to a group of dedicated volunteers, an old damp block became the award-winning museum it is today. ALDERTON VILLAGE HALL – SMART TV

Alderton Parish Council has installed a 65" smart TV and sound bar in the village hall. This was made possible with a grant from the District Council with the help of Cllr James Mallinder, and a Community Interest Company (CIC) set up to help rural and coastal villages purchase new equipment (visit www.suffolkcoastalcic.org). The hall also has broadband using modern technology supplied by FibreWiFi (www.fibrewifi.com). They use Ultrafast Fibre Optic Connections to supply connectivity to transmission points and then use radio, rather than copper phone lines, to connect to the network. The TV can be used by anyone hiring the hall.
