BAWDSEY BEACH BONKERS BEACHCOMBING WORKSHOPS

My name is Kate Osborne and I run Beach Bonkers. I take people on guided beachcombs to treasure hunt Suffolk's shingle beaches. Everything we find tells us a story about our seas. Beachcombing reveals an animal that looks like seaweed; egg cases of creatures we never see that are also cannibals; seashells galore; and fossils including sharks' teeth. There will be a beachcombing workshop in Bawdsey on 15 September. We will spend the morning beachcombing East Lane beach, and in the afternoon will explore your treasures in detail. There's also a Beachcombing and Art workshop on 29 September. We will spend the morning beachcombing and then the artist Carole Massey will show you how to draw your treasures.
