At the CPM held on 14th January 2015 the panel decided our priorities for the following quarter will be:

- 1. To carry out a further programme of speed monitoring and enforcement in the Woodbridge & district SNT area.**
- 2. To carry out parking monitoring and enforcement in the Woodbridge and district SNT area in locations such as schools and those areas raised as a concern by our community.**
- 3. To allay fears of residents relating to illegal immigration/ smuggling between Bawdsey and Orford with patrols**

If you are a member of a ‘watch’ scheme, Police Connect information keeps you up-to-date with the latest issues. It’s also a great way of finding out about local policing events and meetings.

By receiving messages through Police Connect, you are kept in the loop.
