Apart from the above our three hot issues at the moment are:

Coastal Defences at Slaughden - Rocks from Norway are due for delivery by sea at the end of February, assuming they can fit in the window between storm Imogen and storm Jake or Kate! **(ii) Snape wall (FC 6&7) and (iii) Aldeburgh Marsh (FC10) Upgrades** - Discussions and plans are in progress and it is hoped to have costed schemes very shortly. The Partnership will call a community meeting to discuss these in detail as as soon as it is feasible.
